National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) Process

- Enacted in 1969, NEPA requires all federal agencies to evaluate potential environmental impacts of any major actions they may propose and to inform and involve the public in the decision-making process.
- Your comments submitted on the Draft EIS/OEIS will become part of the public record and will be addressed in the Final EIS/OEIS.
- The Final EIS/OEIS will be released to the public. Following the 30-day wait period, the Department of the Navy will issue a Record of Decision.
