Operating Forces

U.S. Fleet Forces

Supports both the Chief of Naval Operations and Combatant Commanders worldwide by providing responsive, relevant and sustainable Naval forces that are ready-for-tasking. In collaboration with U.S. Pacific Fleet, U.S. Fleet Forces organizes, mans, trains, maintains and equips Navy forces, develops and submits budgets, and executes readiness and personnel accounts to develop both required and sustainable levels of Fleet readiness.

Systems Commands

Naval Air Systems Command

Develops, acquires and sustains aircraft systems operated by Sailors and Marines.

Naval Sea Systems Command

Develops, delivers and maintains ships and systems on time and on cost for the Navy.

Office of Naval Research

Coordinates, executes and promotes the science and technology programs of the Navy and Marine Corps.
